



Scholarship Information

Mission Statement:

The Instrumental Music Boosters' scholarships recognize individuals who demonstrate musical excellence, excellence in intellectual development, leadership and contribution to support of the music program by providing financial support to defray costs of future college expenses.

Scholarship Amounts:

1st Place - \$1,000

2nd Place - \$750

3rd Place - \$500

Spirit Award - \$250 (Determined by Junior and Senior student votes. Does not need to submit a scholarship application to win, but also cannot be a winner of one of the above.)

Mandatory Application Criteria (for all of the above except Spirit Award):

Students must meet the following criteria in order to be eligible to apply:

1. The student must have an unweighted grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
2. The student must have been accepted into a college for the upcoming fall.
3. The student must complete the Scholarship Application for music activities beginning the summer before 9th grade through 12th grade.
4. The student must also provide, in the Scholarship Application, their contributions to the LHS Instrumental Music Boosters beginning the summer before 9th grade through 12th grade.
5. The student must ensure that the completed Scholarship Application is received by the boosters' scholarship facilitator on, or by, the due date shown on page 2.

Music Career Summary Items (in order of importance):

1. Participation and excellence in instrumental music activities: wind ensemble, symphonic band, concert band, orchestra, marching band, band front (guard), other ensembles, all-county and all-state bands, jazz band, solo & ensemble festival, school recitals, chorus, school plays, etc. Auditions for all-county and all-state bands and orchestras (regardless of whether or not the student earned a seat) are also considered, as this shows additional effort and initiative above and beyond what is expected by the music teacher or curriculum.

2. Demonstration of leadership: band council, section leader, etc. Some of these positions are elected by students and some are appointed by band director. No matter how the position was achieved, the student fulfilled the additional responsibility and thus this leadership role is also considered.
3. Contribution to the music program by promoting teamwork, cooperation, spirit, etc.
4. Contribution of service to the booster organization - helping with fundraisers and other booster sponsored events such as: marching band competitions, craft fair, funnel cake sales, bingo games, program ad sales, etc.
5. Participation in music activities outside of school: honor bands and orchestras, band camps, special ensembles, guard, drum corps, other bands, accompanists, church music groups, private music instruction, etc.
6. Acquisition of other special music awards.

Guidelines/Comments:

1. This scholarship is based on past high school experience and should not be dependent on the applicant's intended college major.
2. Applications will be mailed to the scholarship facilitator for the booster organization who will convert each application to an anonymous number.
3. If the student's identity should become apparent during the process, no personal knowledge of a student by a committee member should come into play beyond what is included in the application.
4. The scholarship selection committee will remain anonymous.

1. Complete and submit the Liberty High School Instrumental Music Boosters' Student Scholarship Application. Additional items can be included on a separate sheet, as can your essay (Item 3).
