### WHAT IS EXTRAVAGANZA?

- Each year, the Liberty High School Instrumental Music Boosters (IMB) contributes approximately \$50,000 to the entire LHS instrumental music program for new instruments and equipment, instrument repairs, music, scholarships, and student activities and support (trips, concerts, etc.).
- Extravaganza is one of the IMB's first major fundraisers for the school year and is the only home competition for the Liberty marching band.
- Bands from around the region perform themed shows and are judged in several categories (overall music performance, section performance, drill, and color guard). The winning bands receive trophies for the competition. In addition, the scores for each band affect their rankings in the regional Chapter Championship and the Atlantic Coast Championship.

### HOW CAN YOU HELP?

- Volunteers are needed to staff the many staging areas for the visiting bands, concessions, and various other stations. Donations of snacks, water, sodas and paper products are always welcome. ### **VOLUNTEER NEEDS**

#### **Coordinators**

Individuals are needed to coordinate several areas, including the baked goods table, candy grams, and dinner for the marching band that evening.

#### **Preparation and Publicity**

Before Extravaganza, we need assistance with placing signs around the area (in neighborhoods and local establishments), getting advertisers for the program, preparing food for the hot buffet dinner we serve to the LHS marching band the evening of Extravaganza, and with setting up the field and concession areas (the day of the event).

During Extravaganza, we need a number of volunteers in the following areas:

#### **Field and Auxiliary Positions**

- Gate monitors – staff each gate and monitor the entrances and exits
- Band starter – alerts each band when they are allowed to take the field for their performance
- Judges' support – assists the competition judges during the evening
- Announcer – introduces each band and assists with emceeing the event from the broadcast booth
- Parking – monitor the band parking lot and assist with directing visiting bands to the proper area
- Greeters – greet each band and escort them to their assigned area
- Buffet – set up and serve the buffet dinner for the LHS marching band

#### **Pavilion Positions**

- Ticket gate cashiers
- Concessions and drink stands
- Baked goods table
- Candy grams
- Funnel cakes

#### **Runners**

Throughout the event, we need a number of middle school and high school students to serve as runners for various volunteer positions. Service hours are available for any student who volunteers.

#### **Donations**

- Baked goods (individually wrapped items that can be sold during the event)
- Sodas and water
- Individual packages of chips and snacks that can be sold at the concession stand
- Canned chili that can be sold at the concession stand
- Individual packages of candy (candy bars, etc.) that can be sold at the candy grams table
- Hot entrees for the LHS marching band buffet dinner (primarily large pans of baked ziti)
